We'll see you on the courts at Mackinac.

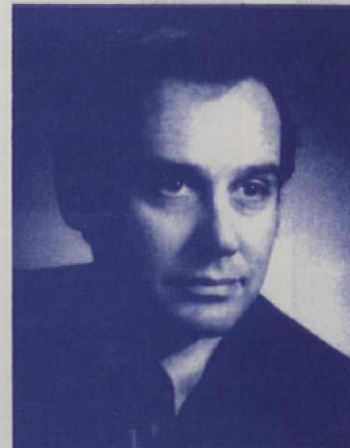
