MAYOR GOODMAN SUPPORTS THE MAYOR'S CLIMATE ACTION AGENDA

The letter also respectfully requested that she join with the other mayors across the country in supporting the Paris Climate Agreement. On August 30th, Jon Sparer, AIA received the following letter from the mayor announcing that she had signed onto the NMCAA. Thank you Mayor Goodman for re-affirming the City's commitment to climate protection and for taking this action on behalf of all citizens.

Thank you for taking the time to write regarding your organization's position on the Mayors National Climate Action Agenda (MNCAA). As Mayor, I value input from professionals like you, and I applaud your activism.

When the U. S. Conference of Mayors first introduced this initiative, the United States had just sworn in a new President. *Out of an abundant respect for that office*, I was willing to wait to learn the new Administration's rationale and proposed policy alternative regarding its withdrawal from the Paris Climate Agreement. 

The AIA Nevada Excellence in Design Awards program is open to all AIA Nevada members who are licensed in the state of Nevada for projects located anywhere in the world, and to AIA members from other states who are licensed in Nevada for projects located in Nevada.

Submittal Categories:

- **Built Architecture** Any project that has been completed since January 1, 2013, including commercial, pubic works, residential, hospitality, interior architecture and all completed projects of any kind.
- **Unbuilt Architecture** Projects that have been commissioned or projects designed as a part of a competition but have not yet been built or may never be built.




2018-2019 WMR Regional Director
