

Vinny Petrarca, Sara Queen, Jay Smith, and David Hill took about 60 NCSU architecture students to Frank Lloyd Wright's Fallingwater August 24-25. Built between 1936 and 1939, the house captured the nation's imagination when it was featured on the cover of *Time* magazine in 1938. The students also studied land next to Fallingwater that is the site for their semester-long studio project. TMH donated breakfast from Bojangles for everyone on Saturday morning.



The 1951 David and Gladys
Wright House in Phoenix AZ
was designed by Frank
Lloyd Wright for his
son. Earlier this year, the
buyer, developers 8081
Meridian Corporation,

promised the house would be preserved. **Now they have backed off that promise**. In July 2012, the <u>Frank Lloyd</u>
<u>Wright Building Conservancy</u> was awarded a temporary
demolition delay while the City of Phoenix decides whether to
