



- Last week, architects [Arthur Cogswell](#) and **Roger Cannon** won the AIA North Carolina's Kamphoefner Prize, the organization's highest honor for Modernist design. Established by founding Dean of the NCSU School of Design [Henry Kamphoefner](#), the award is given every two years.



Architect **Alan Ingram** died November 10 in Charlotte. Born in London, he came to North Carolina in 1956 and practiced architecture internationally for nearly fifty years. 

- Remember last week, when we reported Phoenix's endangered **David and Gladys Wright House**, designed by David's famous father, architect [Frank Lloyd Wright](#), was sold to a new owner who would not tear it down? Well, that [has all changed](#).
- Did you miss the October talk by **Raymond Neutra** about the VDL House and his father, [Richard Neutra](#)? Kate Walker [got it on tape](#).
- Raleigh's proposed Unified Development Ordinance will allow second houses in many backyards. These houses can be two stories tall and to within 10 feet of the rear lot line, which is 20 feet closer than main dwellings are allowed in areas zoned R-2 or R-4. And by state law, the city cannot require that the owner live onsite. Some people fear that these cottages will destroy the wooded nature of neighborhoods; others want the flexibility to create added value to their properties. The Comprehensive Planning Committee will vote soon on whether the cottages should have higher design standards which may include setbacks that match those of the main house, consistent building materials, reducing the number of unrelated people from six to four, and more. Overpricing the property (as it has been for five years) keeps it vacant and vulnerable. You can help influence whether this iconic home is saved - or goes vanishes like the [Catalano House](#) did in 2001.
