

Harwell Hamilton Harris' Ruth Carter Stevenson House in Fort Worth TX is no more. Just a few months after her death earlier this year, the 6000sf house was sold and then destroyed.

Another house saved from the TMH Endangered List! The 1972 Jeter and Peggy Floyd House, 3410 Kem Drive, Winston-Salem. Architect unknown. Foreclosed in 2012. Sold recently to Lynn and Arthur Bernstein; the house will be renovated and not destroyed.


