



Cynthia, along with **Jennifer Martin Mitchell**, is a founding Principal of MdM Historical Consultants. She has authored numerous mid-century National Register nominations in North Carolina, including the 2008 nomination of the Edward Loewenstein-designed Wilbur and Martha Carter House, which is on the upcoming house tour. Mountain College was founded in 1933, using the philosophical principles of education reform as put forth by **John Dewey**, an American intellectual and psychologist. Though lesser known and smaller in size, Black Mountain was equally as progressive

and innovative as the Bauhaus. And during its 24-year lifespan, the school attracted and produced some of the greatest intellectual and creative talents of the 20th century including **Josef and Anni Albers, Jacob Lawrence, Merce Cunningham, Buckminster Fuller, John Cage, Willem and Elaine de Kooning, Robert Rauschenberg, Cy Twombly, Kenneth Noland, Franz Kline, Arthur Penn, Ruth Asawa, M.C. Richards, Francine du Plessix Gray, Robert Motherwell, Charles Olson, Robert Creeley**, and many others. Jurors include NCMH's **George Smart**; artist, educator and videographer **Nancy Bechtol**; and inter-disciplinary artist **Andrew Reach**. [Details](#).
