




# THE GRADUATE <sup>(1967)</sup>

One of North Carolina's endangered Modernist houses is back on the market after nearly being rescued. The 1951 A. M. and Ruth Fleishman Residence, [2614 Morganton Road, Fayetteville NC](#). Designed by Greensboro's [Edward Loewenstein](#). [Jim Brandt](#) was the draftsman. Built by Ed Rynick. It has been vacant for several years and has seriously deteriorated but appears recoverable.
