





New Book available August 1: [Robot House](#), by Peter Testa.





Funded by NC Modernist Houses and the Tashiro Family, the North Carolina Department of Archives and History recently completed a preliminary indexing of the Aiji Tashiro Collection in Raleigh. Aiji Tashiro graduated from the University of Cincinnati and was recruited to Appalachian State University (ASU) in Boone NC as Landscape Architect

and Associate Architect. His brothers Kenji and Arthur and Saburo and sister Aiko, despite being born in America, were all imprisoned with most of the US Japanese citizens during WWII. Aiji escaped internment living in the small NC town, although he was publicly investigated. Tashiro resisted being labeled a specialist in any aspect of design work, preferring a wide variety of projects, clients, and challenges. [Profile and projects.](#)
