





The Durham City Council is including preservation of 1957 Home Security Life Building among its priorities for redevelopment of the four-acre former police headquarters site. While creating affordable housing units in proximity to downtown and public transit is clearly at the top of the list, Mayor Steve Schewel and the Council have acknowledged the significance of the building and the opportunity to create a mixed-use “landmark” project as a gateway to our historic downtown. City staff will now craft a request for proposals that meets council's goals. **Preservation Durham** will continue efforts to place the building on the National Register of Historic Places, making it eligible for historic tax credits.
