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CARTE BLANCHE

A CLIENT'S TRUST IN HIS DESIGNERS LEADS TO AN AWARD-WINNING GUEST HOUSE ON FIRE ISLAND.

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A bond of trust between a client, his architects and his interior designer has inspired an award-winning guest house on Fire Island - created from Italian ceramic tile, inside and out.

"The client basically said: 'We know what you do - just go ahead and do it," says Scott Bromley, principal in the New Yorkbased firm of Bromley Caldari Architects.

They'd already worked mightily to gain that trust - by designing a main residence, a gym and a pool house in a compound of buildings for the client – along with interior designer Alexander Baer of Jenkins Baer Associates.

"The ease of working with a client who understands you is important - he doesn't question everything you do" Baer says. "He's comfortable with your choices and he gets the concept and he doesn't have to see every doorknob in the house. It's a wonderful experience to have a client who lets you run with it."

The result? A 2,500-square-foot, transparent structure clad in a sandy-colored porcelain tile from Emil Ceramica in Fiorano, Italy. It's named "Soft," but Bromley calls it a "gray-sy, beige-y, tan-ny" tone. It matches up to its surroundings on the beach overlooking the Atlantic. "We chose it because it reminds you of the sand and the dune grass," he says. "We wanted the structure to blend in with Mother Nature. There's also a slightly tinted, clear cedar decking - similar to the tile - that creates an envelope for the house."

The structure is a renovation of an existing 1960s building, designed for the client's two sisters. The assignment was to create a series of maintenance-free spaces for entertaining. Thus the porcelain tile. "It's perfect, because it's indestructible," he says. "Red wine and margaritas won't stain it."

The tiles are mostly 24 by 24 inches, except in the baths, where they're 12 inches square. "We changed the tile there for a little more grit and texture, so you don't slip coming out of the shower," Bromley says. "They're the same basic color, but a little more mottled."

In terms of interiors, the idea was to maximize the views and minimize the clutter. "Fire Island is about uncomplicated



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design, and I wanted something natural," Baer says. "It's midcentury modern, with an Italian flavor – streamlined and simple and easy for guests."

The house is designed for casual living at the beach, with an open kitchen, living room and dining area. The spaces are unencumbered, and aimed at encouraging human interaction. "They're places where people can hang around while cooking in the kitchen – it's very inter-playable," Bromley says.

The original building was not as big, with a warren of rooms and much smaller windows. Bromley opened it all up, enclosed an interior courtyard and turned it into a dining area, where a lighting pendant now floats over the table to create a defining element.

The home contains three bedrooms,

three baths, a powder room and a kitchen. The architect left the sunken living room as is, incorporating it into his sunsplashed, open plan. "There's a clerestory, so it's full of light – a really wonderful place to be in a public space, and to see the ocean and the pool and the outside dining area," he says.


Baer worked hand-in-glove with Bromley to make the views accessible, keeping artwork to a minimum and using simple, modular furniture. "It's architectural in nature – I wanted to keep it low, so you can see over it to the water," he says. "There's as little wall art as possible, so you can appreciate the environment all around."


Where some interior designers might depend on a signature look, Baer looks instead

to his clients' needs. In this case, he kept the walls, furniture and accessories in the same neutral palette as the tiles. "They all act as compatible elements to one another, for a complicity in design," he says. "It's plain and uncluttered, with the furniture in straight lines."

Each of the three players involved in this renovation – the client, the architect and the interior designer – have lived on Fire Island at one point or another in their lives, which Baer says made it easy to pull the project together. "We all understood the flavor of the





island," he says. "It's like a big summer camp for adults—it's not like the Hamptons or Florida—and you don't get that if you haven't live there."

Each also understood the roles of the others involved in the design. "It was a team that completely related to each other," Baer says. "There was a mutual understanding."

He and Bromley, in particular, work well together – something that's often all too rare when an architect and interior designer collaborate on a project. Architects, Baer says, sometimes feel threatened by designers, fearful that they'll come in behind them and ob-

scure or even destroy their work.

That certainly was not the case here. "Scott has a really classic background, and it's always a pleasure to work with him," Baer says. "You don't have to cover up a flaw or a wall – it's a beautiful palette."

THE AWARD

So why Italian porcelain? "They have the best stuff, and seem to be the product we encounter most often" says Jerry Caldari, Bromley's partner. "They've been doing it for centuries – go to Pompeii and you'll see it there."

Or to Bologna – where Caldari and Bromley

The design offers a view of the living room, dining room and kitchen – all as one element

spent time last September. When their guest house design won first place in the residential category in the 2017 Ceramics of Italy Tile Competition, they also won a trip to Cersaie, the world's largest ceramic tile exhibition there.

That's proof that a client who gives carte blanche to his designers can win in more ways than one. •


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PRIVATE ISLAND PARADISE

PRIVACY IS THE ULTIMATE LUXURY IN THE BAHAMAS.

When Melanie and Paul Wagner purchased

Elizabeth Island in the Bahamas, they started with nothing but a caved in-cistern and a ruin of a boathouse that had been abandoned for 50 years. They had to bring everything: barge loads of building materials, appliances, and furniture and today, the "simple life" in the Wagner's' private compound in the Lower Exumas features a nearly 360-degree view of the harbor, swathes of lush greenery, several beaches, and the endless blue waters of Exuma Sound. On their 38-acre property, the couple have freedom to roam, find tranquility, and create art. (In Bahamas

fashion, the Wagners have a renewable 2,000-year lease on the island, now sharing it with two other families.)

A boathouse contains the family's public space, including the kitchen, dining area, office, and laundry. The three-story Cistern House – literally built over the cistern water source – has a master suite on the top floor, where the name of the house, Top of the World, proves itself. On the second floor are three more bedrooms and two baths. The ground floor is divided into a garage, workshop, and art studio. The studio, which overlooks a courtyard, is key to the couple's working life and a passionate interest: creating art.

Paul Wagner's father was the late Sherle Wagner, who designed decorative hardware and bath fixtures. Ahead of his time, Sherle Wagner also designed a line of contemporary furniture with materials such as mirror-finished stainless steel and semi-precious stones. Paul Wagner had a career designing for the company and now designs sculptural wood furniture for the family. Many of his pieces and special light fixtures decorate the Bahamas property.

Melanie Wagner designs glass jewelry, constructs sculptures with driftwood and other beach finds, and also paints. Their daughter, Chloe, is a jewelry maker and son Jeremy is an artist, as is his wife, the printmaker Jiyoung Park.


The family's most sizeable art project is the Bahamas house. "Melanie and I designed and oversaw every aspect of the project, carrying out much of the work ourselves," Paul Wagner says, including a gazebo they built with their son at the highest elevation on the island, 75 feet.

For two years, the family used hand tools to clear the two miles of trails that weave around the island's private beaches. They also maintain the protected two-acre marina.

But mostly Elizabeth Island is the same as it ever was. There is no pavement and the lagoon, surrounded by mangroves, has noth-









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


ing manmade except two floating docks. "We're very tuned into the beauty of the island," Melanie Wagner says.

The island has meant a lot to the couple. "For both of us, it's been the freedom to be and do as we please," Paul Wagner says. "It gives us an independence we've grown to cherish."

Now the Wagners are being lured back to a life closer to their mainland roots and have placed Top of the World on the market. The family will move to another island, the more settled Martha's Vineyard, off the Massachusetts coast.

Somehow it seems there always will be an island in the couple's life. "For us," Paul Wagner says, "the ultimate luxury has been the enjoyment of our lifestyle, surrounded by the natural beauty and crystal-clear waters of the Exumas." *







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THE FLYRIDE TAKES OFF... LITERALLY. BY SHAUN TOLSON

Since 2011, Franky Zapata has invented a

slew of unique aquatic-based toys, the most famous of which is the flyboard, a machine that allows users-secured in a standing position—to propel themselves dozens of feet above the surface of the water. The French inventor, who previously earned seven European championships and two world championships as a professional personal watercraft racer during the late 1990s and throughout the 2000s, declared that his unique watersports vehicles and apparatuses were created to satisfy people's dreams of "leaping out of the water and soaring through the air."

One of Zapata's latest vehicles, the Fly-Ride, is a personal watercraft, similar to a jet ski, which allows users to experience its French creator's unique version of hydroflight while being tethered to an actual jet ski that trails behind it. Programmed with four ability modes and proclaimed to be the market's first hydroflyer with intelligent flight control and stabilization, the FlyRide churns out as much as 400 horsepower and can fly-quite literally—as fast as 22 mph. Best of all, it offers users the thrill of a barrel roll with the push of a button. .




esting serenely on a bluff in Malibu is a 13,335 square-foot residence lifted 70 feet up into California's rarified air.


It looks past the Pacific Coast Highway below, straight out to an unobstructed, 180-degree expanse of ocean and sky. "There's a visual, visceral and auditory view of the water," says its owner, Ron Heller. "You can enjoy the beach and the privacy of the cliff – and you feel like you're on the ocean."

Seventeen properties have been developed in Marisol Malibu, the development where it's located – with 13 parcels sold, four still available, and seven homes built. All except Heller's (Marisol 4) have hewed toward more traditional design. So why go contemporary with this one?

"The younger buyers want a more modern design," says architect Doug Burdge, founder of the Malibu firm that bears his name. "The developer was looking at the marketplace and what to do for the next 10 years since he's already been successful for the past 10 years."







Architect Doug Burdge designed the 12,000 square-foot home with guest house and garage. The home features an infinity poot, a rarity in Malibu. Sliding doors open up from an living area inside to a bar space outside. Interior designer Gail Coleman staged the completed house with custom furniture and finishes.

And because there was no architectural review board for Marisol Malibu, the developer could do what his architect suggested. "He liked our work flow and floor plan," Burdge says.

As did Heller. Before he bought the home, he'd already purchased a lot and another more traditional residence in the development. But he became intrigued while he witnessed this minimalist gem under construction. "I watched the house from the day they poured the foundation," he says. "I walked through it, wondering what it would be like to live here."

So the former Audi and Land Rover dealer from San Antonio sold his house, bought Marisol 4, then sold his lot. Now he looks out to his own private Pacific with views from his covered patio, private beach and infinity pool, outside a 28-foot-wide expanse of sliding doors.

"It's about inside to outside living," he says. "The pocket doors open up from east to

west all the way from where the kitchen starts, with 15 feet facing the ocean. There's one supporting pillar and the rest of the sliding doors open up, right out to the bar area."

Upstairs on the second floor is a similar configuration for the private living areas. ""It's open from my office on the left side to the master with its long balcony," he says. "Then you go into the master bath, with white marble and a freestanding tub – and it opens up for an outdoor shower and bath experience."

It's all part of the Southern California, inside/outside way of life. If it's 75 degrees with no humidity, why not open the doors and let it the fresh air in? "It's the way people want to be and the way they were raised," Burdge says. "It's the lifestyle in this climate – you can live inside or outside."

As he worked through the home's design, Burdge explored the dual concepts of opacity and transparency where appropriate. He created a home that's hidden as it faces the street, and wide open where it overlooks the ocean. "There were privacy issues on the front, so we used high grasses there," he says. "It's opaque there and on the sides, and transparent on the beach side."

The thoughtful landscaping with tall palm trees and other plantings has an impact on Heller as he approaches the house. "When I drive in, I see how much time was spent with their positioning," he says. "It's all arranged in a way that's very organic."

The home presents itself in a cinematic way as he pulls in from the street, slips through the gate and heads down the drive. "The descent reveals the home like a movie opening up," he says. "It has a really tropical feel – and it's expensive and difficult to do that right."

That was a deliberate gesture on the part of Burdge, who says that for an approach to the entry of a home like this, the idea is to see nature, and not cars. So he placed the garage and the automobiles out of sight, allowing commanding views to present themselves. "You enter and see the ocean," the architect says. "You see and explore the house and the surprises around the corners – the den and guest bedrooms are in surprising places."

With seven bedrooms and 11 baths, the home itself is about 11,800 square feet, with an additional 1,4940 square feet under covered porches and pavilions. Gail Coleman of On





Pointe Design handled the interiors with custom furniture, and chose finishes that the developer approved. "They spared no expense," she says.


The lower level of the two-story home features limestone floors, a custom-designed French Oak stairwell, furnishings from Italian manufacturer Minotti, and more French oak for flooring. "It's marine quality, to work with the humidity and dampness," she says. "It's everywhere where there isn't any limestone – downstairs in all the bedrooms, and it goes up the stairs and carries through the entire second story."


When she designs a high-end home like this, her focus is to stick with a neutral palette and show the bones of the house, for something that appeals to the masses. Because it was a developer's spec house, the architect faced a similar challenge. "You have to guess on the eventual owner, and that they'll be okay with how big the guest rooms or baths are," Burdge says. "They have to understand this is a gym and that's a master, and they have to understand how it will all be used."

Ron Heller got that, and this spec home's ceaseless view of the Pacific Ocean, immediately. *

indoor and outdoor luxury living becoming increasingly blurred—and not just in California and Florida—homeowners are pushing the envelope. They want their fresh-air environments to snap, crackle and pop, just like their spare-no-expense homes.

From the viewpoint of a chaise lounge in a gazebo overlooking an infinity pool, say, a well-orchestrated illuminated landscape plays up all the bells and whistles—pools, spas, fountains, waterfalls and grottos, to name a few. Light, when added strategically and with a designer's eye, accentuates what's beautiful and ensures that anything less is cast in shadow.


The recent history of landscape illumination technology, as in other areas of the lighting industry, can be divided into two categories: before and after LED. The migration of outdoor lighting from older technologies, like halogen, incandescent and fluorescent, to LED has brought numerous benefits including longer bulb life, better energy efficiency and low maintenance. His solution was to use high quality material such as solid brass and copper—now the industry standard—instead of plastic and aluminum, to combat the effects of salt, sea, and time.

"We take pride in providing lifetime solutions to our customers' needs; whether it's a standard product, a mounting solution, or a custom fixture design," explains Jason Kessel, Auroralight's marketing communications manager, who adds that their unique AMS mount design allows lights to "tilt, pivot, spin and rotate without twisting wires for the perfect angle to light your space."

Auroralight's most recent luminaire designs are meant to be minimal and discrete, like the Scepter, whose ultra-compact size makes it easy to install inconspicuously into planters and is ideal for illuminating pathways and intimate garden areas. Hidden or not, it's important to the company that all its products achieve the best performance and are made from the highest quality materials and adhere to design standards that are modern yet timeless.

According to Kessel, a new product launching soon is Auroralight's catenary cable mounting system, with which lights can be hung in an attractive pattern of staggered lengths, perfect for outdoor plazas and intimate dining patios. A brass junction box hides the wiring and makes for easy serviceability. "Catenary lighting is on trend, so Auroralight is providing a more compact, yet robust solution for those projects." says Kessel. auroralight.com

PAL LIGHTING USA

From spas to spillovers, fountains to fire bowls, the sky may not even be the limit to fantastical effects in today's world of luxury pool design. "With negative edge pools, why not light up the trough?" asks Ray Thibault. "Raised columns might support a fire bowl, so why not light up the edges of the col-

umns?" Thibault, director of business development for PAL Lighting USA (the North American agent for the Australian company Bellson Electric) has seen a lot of change during his 15 years with the company. In the 1990s, Sydney-based Bellson started by outfitting fiberglass pools in the Australian market with a low-voltage, self-enclosed pool light using a Xenon bulb. With the advent of low-voltage LED pool illumination in 2008, which PAL was the first to introduce, lighting

systems got safer. With 12-volt and smaller LEDs, however, more lights had to be used to get the desired effects, instead of using one huge light in the pool end.

Benefits include more complete illumination of the pool with mini lights on entry steps, swimouts and tanning ledges. Perimeter lighting creates a whole new look for the pool and makes stepping pads look like they're floating on water. Waterfall or rain curtain illumination is now easy and home-

owners can even have integrated landscape and backyard feature lighting.

Once the safety issue was addressed, manufacturers and designers focused on improving upon the wow factor. After all, says Thibault, "The real beauty is looking at the effects of the lights."

PAL introduced safe color change to the pool environment, and with electronic power supplies the user just has to put their thumb on the color wheel to control the color and

Among the many showstopping examples of Crenshaw's contributions are a pair of intricate 10-foot exterior niche sconces with cast aluminum leaves (each back-lit)

flanking the main entry. Clean-lined contemporary sconces illuminate the pool. Not all of the company's projects are as substantial and high-profile as this one, but the majority of customers, whether corporate, government or private, require the utmost level of product, performance and painstaking craftsmanship.

"We don't want to hide the 'jewelry' of the space," says Patrick Gable, marketing coordinator at Crenshaw, a custom decorative lighting company well known for impeccable historical restoration and replication. Not only do the fabricators, engineers and designers at Crenshaw create beautiful, thoughtful designs, they also achieve high performance. "Our goal is to not interrupt historic aesthet-

Everything anyone wants to know about

The Ford Plantation in Richmond Hill, Ga. can probably be learned from John and Laura Lee Samford.

She's an interior designer with a penchant for American Saddlebred horses. He's a retired attorney who can't spend enough time on his boat.

In 2000, the Birmingham couple saw an ad in The Wall Street Journal for this lush residential community on the banks of the

Low Country's Ogeechee River. It showcased an enticing deepwater marina - and a worldclass equestrian facility.

Their response was immediate. "We came over and looked at it - and made an offer on a one-acre lot before we left that weekend," he says. "The first time we were there we had dinner in the clubhouse, and by the end of the evening we knew everyone."

It was instant camaraderie, complete with invitations for fishing and golfing.



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"This is a true sporting community," he says. "For a naturalist, there's almost anything you want to do."

By 2005, they'd built a 3,800 square-foot home. A friend drew up construction documents while Laura Lee designed the interiors.

They sold their home in Birmingham and settled in. Now they're neighbors to owners of about 250 other properties, from 2,200-square foot cottages to 16-acre estate lots. Membership in the community is capped


at 400 homes, many with views to the river, the marsh or the golf course.

Each member was drawn by the natural beauty of Ford's 1,800 acres – and the people who live there. "It's very small, and very private – and you know everyone," he says.

Besides outdoor adventures on site, other experiences await nearby. Savannah's arts, parks and music scene are 25 minutes away, and six beaches are within 45-minutes. "Anything you want is here in your own back yard," says Marc Ray, general manager at Ford.







Nearby is a 300-year-old allée of live oaks, their Spanish moss swaying in the breeze. They're part of the former rice plantation's rich and varied heritage.

That's something that a knowledgeable John Samford's happy to talk about. After all, he just wrapped up writing a book on the plantation's history. •


