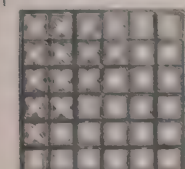
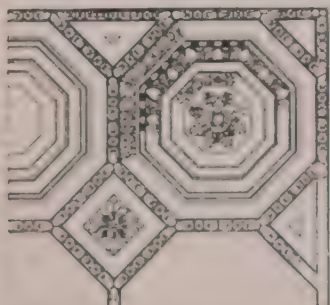
SECTION THRO' PATIO AND STAIRCASE

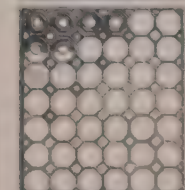

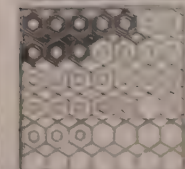
CARVED WOOD CEILINGS TO ROOMS ON PRINCIPAL FLOOR OF THE PALACIO ARZOBISNAL



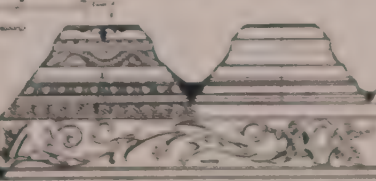
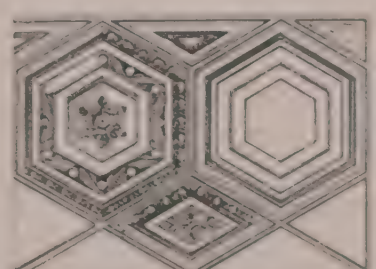
PLAN OF CEILING TO ROOM A
