EXPLANATORY NOTE: This index covers the second year of HORIZON, A Magazine of the Arts, published bi-monthly as a periodical in book form—i.e., with hard covers and without advertising.

HORIZON's purpose is to unite art and ideas in a modern "museum without walls," a handsome showcase for man's creative talents from the cultures of the past to the flowering of tomorrow's civilization.

The index is divided into two parts.

Part one, the General Index, is an index of subjects, authors, names, and places appearing in the six issues which comprise the second year of HORIZON, September 1959 through July 1960.

Part two is a separate Index of Illustrations. Because of the great emphasis placed on fine pictorial reproduction, both artist and title of the many important works which have appeared in HORIZON can be found in this section.
