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EXPLANATORY NOTE: This index covers the sixth year of HORIZON, A Magazine of the Arts, published quarterly as a periodical in book form—i.e., with hard-covers and without advertising.

HORIZON's purpose is to unite art and ideas in a modern "museum without walls," a handsome showcase for man's creative talents from the cultures of the past to the flowering of tomorrow's civilization.

The index is divided into two parts:

Part one, the General Index, is an index of subjects, authors, names, places, and titles appearing in the four issues which comprise the sixth year of HORIZON, Winter, 1964, through Autumn, 1964.

Part two is a separate Index of Illustrations. Because of the emphasis placed on pictorial reproduction, illustrations are listed by title.
