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HORIZON's purpose is to unite art and ideas in a modern "museum without walls," a handsome showcase for man's creative talents from the cultures of the past to the flowering of tomorrow's civilization.

The Index is divided into two parts:

Part one, the General Index, is an index of subjects, authors, names, places, and titles appearing in the four issues that comprise the eighth year of HORIZON, Winter 1966 through Autumn 1966. Part two is a separate Index of Illustrations.

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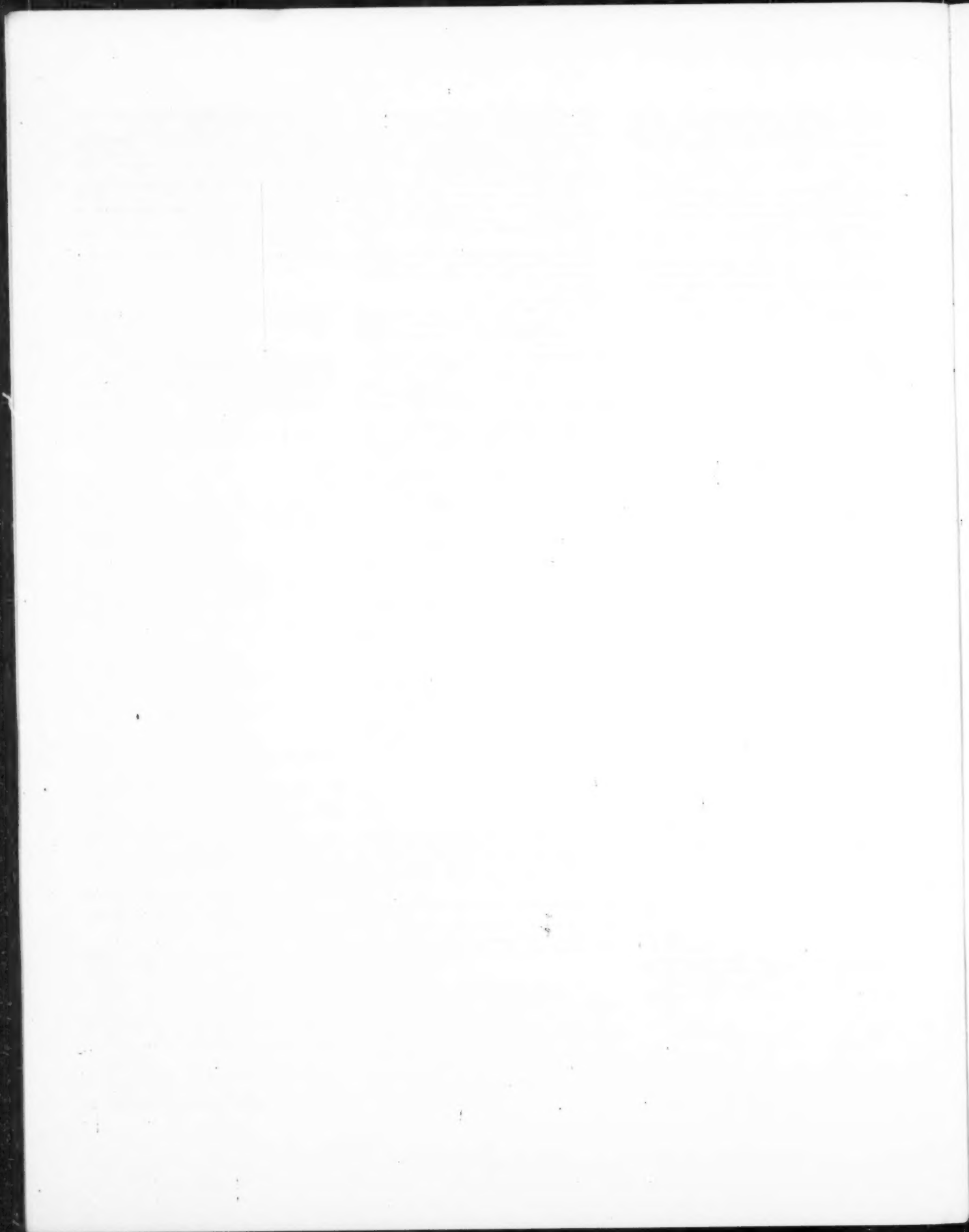
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
